



Percentage Economically Disadvantaged







Proficiency in Subject Areas









Percent graduating within four years at Research Triangle Hi





Percent Scoring 17 or above at Research Triangle Hi





Passing Math 3


Percent Passing at Research Triangle Hi









Percentage of students participating in state mandated standardized testing.





Students with Disabilities Alternate Test Participation




Per Pupil Source of Funding




