Off-Campus Lunch Permission Form
Thursday, December 18, 2025 | 11:40 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.

Participation in this off-campus lunch day is a **privilege** that is being granted to members of the senior class who are considered “in good standing.” This means:

- They have 4 or fewer unexcused absences in any class for the semester (August 11 - December 17).
- They have 9 or fewer unexcused tardies across all classes for the quarter (October 20 - December 17).

In order to leave campus at lunch, this permission form must be turned in to a designated admin member no later than 3:45 p.m. on Tuesday, December 16, 2025. No late forms will be accepted.

Admin will assess all permission forms turned in against eligibility criteria and generate an approved list. Students on that approved list can pick up a wristband before school or at the start of lunch on Thursday, December 18, 2025 in the school lobby. Students should plan accordingly for the time it takes to pick up their wristband.

Upon attempting to leave campus, all students will have to show their wristbands to the SRO or Admin Team Member at the top of the driveway, whether walking or driving. Students should also have in their possession a valid photo ID (driver license, RTHS ID, etc.) and should be able to present the photo ID if requested. Any students who attempt to leave campus without the required items will be subject to disciplinary action.

1. Students who use the off-campus lunch privilege are subject to the rules of student conduct as applicable to the regular school day, adopted in the Student/Parent Handbook. Behavior off campus during the lunch period should be in compliance with school expectations and policies; infractions off campus may result in disciplinary actions.
2. Student drivers are responsible for knowing if persons riding with them have a wristband and photo ID. Any student who provides transportation for a student who does not have those items will be subject to disciplinary action, including detention and revocation of their parking pass.
3. Student drivers who attempt to transport students concealed in trunks/cargo areas will be subject to disciplinary action, including detention and revocation of their parking pass.
4. Failure to return to class on time after the lunch period will result in the revocation of any future off-campus lunch privileges and detention. RTHS encourages ordering ahead online to avoid waiting in lines at restaurants. Students are subject to a teacher’s

classroom rules about any food they bring back to campus.

5. Students may return to campus early but must abide by established school lunch rules, including not remaining in the student parking areas.
6. The student and the parent are responsible for where the student goes for lunch and for transportation. The school assumes no liability for any accident or injury incurred in the exercise of the off-campus lunch privilege.
